# 2018 – 11<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL CLEANUP

- Saturday, April 7th
  - 9am: Volunteer Registration / Welcome
  - 10am: Commence Cleanup / Project
  - 1pm: Conclude Cleanup Operation
  - 2pm: Closing / Thank Volunteers and **notify the**
- Streets Department Collection
  - All bags should be taken to designated project pick-up location
  - All cleaning materials should be returned to host site
  - Supplies are gifts to host sites to maintain areas after Cleanup



# COLLECTION

- Biodegradable bags will be distributed for trash, recyclable, and yard waste collection
- Place bags in designated “curbside” location, accessible by trash compactor unit
- Trash, recyclable and yard waste material should be placed in separate bags
  - Label Trash, recycling and yard waste bags accordingly
  - Trash, recyclable and yard waste material should be placed in separate locations for pick up
  - Bags should not weigh more than 45 pounds EACH
  - Tires will also be collected
    - Any tires collected should be stacked on a curb
