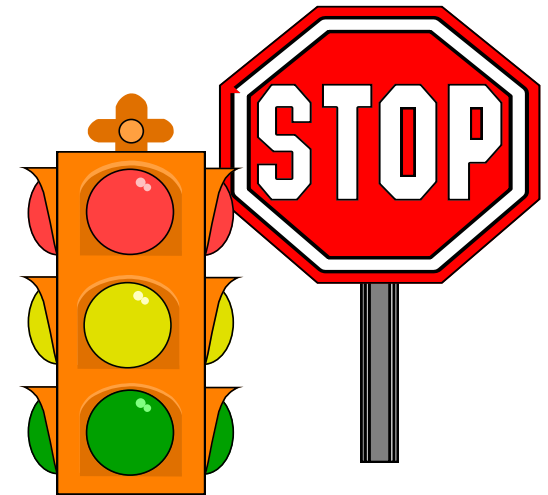

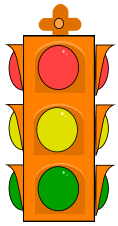

Traffic Engineering

The Traffic Engineering Division is responsible for all traffic control devices on surface streets in the City of Philadelphia. This includes approximately:



2,180 miles of city streets
360 miles of state highways
2,950 signalized intersections
3,000 all-way stop intersections
15,000 conventional stop intersections

Our services range from parking concerns on the smallest local street to the safe and efficient movement of over 95,000 vehicles/day on a 12-lane boulevard with 60 signalized intersections.



1. Contact the Streets Department's Customer Affairs Unit at 215-686-5560 between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM when:

- A traffic sign/street name sign is missing.
- The white/yellow paint lines or crosswalks on the street are missing or faded.
- Parked cars are blocking a driveway. Request a Driveway Paint Permit. Provide your name and address and an application will be mailed to you.
- A traffic signal is malfunctioning, turned, out, knocked down, or otherwise needs repair (after 5:00 PM, call 311).

2. Contact the Philadelphia Parking Authority for information when you need:

- Signs for Limited Time Parking .
- Signs for Handicap Parking (215-683-9735).
- Residential permit parking (215-683-9729).
- Loading Zones (215-683-9738).

- When an All-Way Stop sign may be needed. Your request will be acknowledged and a study will commence. We are obligated by the results of the study.
- When you wish to prohibit trucks from parking on a residential street.
- When there may be a need to install or change a traffic signal installed (e.g., more green time, an arrow, etc.).



4. Contact your District Councilperson when:

- You wish to change the direction of traffic on your street. Upon receipt of the request from Council, the Streets Department's Traffic Division will investigate the effect on safety and circulation.
- Requesting flashing lights for your child's school. The school principal should request an application.

5. Contact the Streets Department's Traffic Division at 215-686-5525 or 5531 no later than three business days prior to your need when:

You wish to temporarily prohibit parking for moving, construction work, delivery, etc. **Requests made later than 3 business days will not be processed.** There is a permit fee of \$25.00 per 40 feet of space (40' equals two parking spaces.)

6. Contact the Streets Department's Traffic Division at 215-686-5524, or Highway Division at 215-686-5500 when:

You wish to start the permit process to block the street and sidewalk. You will need to explain why, how long, and when.
